



Golf Handicap and Information Network (GHIN)

GHIN was developed in 1981 by the United States Golf Association at the request of state and regional golf associations. The USGA's GHIN service is the largest handicap computation provider in the world. It is offered exclusively through state and regional associations, locally the KCGA: Kansas City Golf Association, as a service for their member clubs to assist in meeting the policies of the USGA Handicap System, which enables all golfers to compete on a relatively equal basis. The USGA charges member clubs for each active GHIN member at the club. The club then charges each member for the service.

2018 Annual GHIN Handicap Fee

\$40 per Adult

\$25 per Junior – Age 18 & under

All monthly golf dues paying members in good standing are billed automatically on their March golf statement annually to insure continued service. All other golfers must renew or establish their GHIN handicap in the Golf Shop.
