## Formats – All Formats are Net

**Individual Net** – Your 18 hole score minus your handicap. Lowest net score wins.

**Individual Nassau** – Winners will be determined by the lowest front 9 score, back 9 score and total score for all 18 holes.

**ABCD Four Person Two Better Ball** – Teams will be determined by an ABCD draw for even handicaps. Teams will use the lowest two net scores on each hole and add these scores from each hole to determine their overall score.

**Two Person Odd/Even (Blind Draw)** – Players will be paired based on handicaps that pair teams as evenly as possible. Teams will not know which holes their scores count until after the round. The golf shop will determine which holes each players scores count after all groups are on the course. Your score will count on either all even holes (2, 4, 6, 8, etc.) or all odd holes (1, 3, 5, 7, etc.). Thus, each team will have one score for each hole that the Golf Shop will add together for your 18 hole score.

**ABCD 3, 2, 1** – Four-person ABCD teams. Three (3) scores will count from your team on each par 3, two (2) scores will count from your team on each par 4 and one (1) score will count on each par 5 to determine your team score. For example, hole 1 is a par 4 which rules state two (2) best balls will count. Player A makes a net 4, Player B makes a net 5, Player C makes a net 3 and Player D makes a net 6. Your score for hole number one would be  $3+4=7$ .

**One Man Scramble** – Each player will hit two balls, then select the best shot. You will continue to do so until the ball is holed. Each player receives 50% of their handicap. Please write down your gross score.

**Two Man 9 & 9 - Holes 1-9 – Scramble** – Each team member will receive a percentage of your front 9 handicap. The low handicap player will receive 35% and the high handicap player will receive 15% for your combined scramble handicap as noted on your scorecard. You are allowed one club-length relief and you may change cuts of grass. Teams must use a minimum of 3 tee shots per player.

Holes 10-18 – Shamble – Each team member will receive 50% of their back 9 handicap. Scorecards are dotted accordingly. Both players will tee off and you will select the best tee shot. Players will play their own ball for the remainder of the hole.

**Individual Stableford** – Points are awarded based on your net score for each hole. 1 point for bogey, 2 points for par, 3 points for birdie, 4 points for eagle and 5 points for double eagle. The player with the most points is declared the winner.

**ABCD Four Person Scramble** – All players will tee off and select the best shot. Play will continue this way until the ball is holed. Teams must use a minimum of 2 tee shots from each player.

**ABCD** – Each ABCD format will have players separated by handicap in  $\frac{1}{4}$ 's. The top  $\frac{1}{4}$  are A players, the next  $\frac{1}{4}$  B, next  $\frac{1}{4}$  C and the last  $\frac{1}{4}$  D players. Blind draw if less than 4 players.
