You can renew your membership or sign up in the golf shop any time after February 1st. Please fill out the enrollment form completely so we can update our contact information and get your tee preference.

All events will be played from the White Tee unless you have chosen to play the Gold Tee. On your registration sheet, once your tee selection is picked, you may not change it. Those players will be allowed to play the Gold Tee except in the Member|Guest Tournament and the League Horse Race.

Wednesday Night League will be 20 weeks, starting on April 8th and ending on September 2nd, with the year-end Shoot-Out on Saturday, October 3rd. In case of weather situations, there are rain dates schedule to make up any league nights that cannot be completed. As a reminder, league begins at 5:45 pm. NEW EVENT - POT OF GOLD

On Sunday, May 3rd, the CMGA will host the Pot of Gold Tournament. This event will be an 18-Hole Par Three (3) event. Every hole on the course will be played as a par three. If a hole-in-one is made on any hole, a hole-in-one pot will be rewarded. Currently, there are three hole in one pots. IF, more than three aces are recorded, the total pots will be divided by how many aces were made that day.

New Handicap League Rules

To start off the 2020 golf season, if you do not have an active and established USGA Handicap, you will not be eligible to play in the match play during league night; however, this will not exclude you from playing during those evenings until a Handicap has been established.

For those new golfers with no handicap, you will only pay one dollar (\$1) on league night that will go directly to the Hole-In-One fund.

This has been established to protect the field so that there is equitable competition at all times with established USGA GHIN Handicaps.

Match Forfeiture - Play Protocol

In the rare occurrence that a player has to leave the golf course during the stipulated round for any reason (sickness, family emergency, etc.), the following protocols must be followed and agreed upon by the two players engaged in the match:

- Option One:** **A Gentleman's Tie - The two engaged in the match declare that they will agree to a tie, resulting in a split of the points, five to each player.**
- Option Two:** **The status of the match when forfeiture occurs, then carries into a match against Par. For example, if player A is two up after two holes and has an emergency and player B wants to carry his match into a match against Par, player B will start the third hole two down against Par. Player A will receive the two points that he earned, or whatever that value is at the point of forfeiture.**

The 2020 Beast - Handicapping

With changes to the USGA GHIN System for calculating handicaps, all guests must have an official USGA GHIN Handicap. No forms of handicapping through online applications that are not affiliated with their local golf association.

Online applications such as “The Grint” will not be acceptable forms of handicapping for The Beast nor any other type of event.

Please remind your guest about this early in the season, and if they need assistance with establishing a handicap, have them contact the Golf Shop.

On the evening of Wednesday, August 5th, there will be no Men’s League Play; however, there will be an optional 9-Hole game for you and your guest. More details to come in the future.
